Tonight's Featured Artists

David Garrett has been a member of the Los Angeles Philharmonic since 2000. Previously he was a member of the Houston Symphony, assistant principal of the San Antonio Symphony, and a member of the New Orleans Philharmonic. Garrett also appears frequently as a recitalist, chamber musician, and soloist, and is a frequent performer on the Philharmonic's Chamber Music Society and Green Umbrella concerts.

Garrett has recorded modern cello works for the Albany and Opus One labels; his doctoral dissertation includes publication of previously unknown baroque cello works, and he pursues the standard literature in regular solo and chamber music performances. Garrett also enjoys teaching; currently, he teaches cello at California State University, Long Beach.

Paul Stein has performed with the Los Angeles Philharmonic since 1981 and was featured as soloist at the Hollywood Bowl. He was principal second violinist with the Colorado Symphony and performed with the Santa Fe Opera orchestra.

Paul has produced children's concerts with Chamber Music Express since 1985. He has written stories to accompany the programs, including Galileo's Metronome, The Voyage of the Viola, Parts 1 and 2, and Philharmonic Truck Stop. He produced the Midsummer Nights' Music series at the Pasadena Jewish Temple and Center for six years and is currently director of the Classical Kaleidoscope chamber music series at the Arcadia Library. He teaches violin and viola at his home in Monrovia and is on the faculties of Pasadena City College and Glendale College.
